### Wise Choice design competition terms and conditions:



1. Entry is free and is open to all participating schools in Australia.
2. The competition opens on Tuesday 1 September 2009 and closes at 5.00pm Eastern Standard Time on Tuesday 31 August 2010.
3. Schools may submit designs for any new product that can be manufactured from recycled-plastic. Schools are encouraged to visit the Replas website - [www.replas.com.au](http://www.replas.com.au) - to view the current range, obtain design guidelines and receive handy hints and ideas. Schools are entitled to enter up to three designs into the competition.
4. Entries should be posted to: Wise Choice Design Competition, Replas, 27 Titan Drive, Carrum Downs, Victoria, 3201 or emailed to: [wisecoice@replas.com.au](mailto:wisecoice@replas.com.au)
5. Judging will take place during the week commencing 6 September 2010. The judging panel will select the design that they believe to have the best form and function and the most commercial potential. The decision of the panel of judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. The winning school will be notified by phone on Friday 10 September 2010, and an announcement notice will appear on the RED by Green Bag website - [redbygreenbag.com.au](http://redbygreenbag.com.au) - and in the September edition of the Replas newsletter.
7. The winning design will be added to the range of Replas recycled-plastic products and will be made available for purchase. The design may have to be modified by Replas to allow for production techniques. All entries will become the intellectual property of Replas. Replas retains the right to set the selling price of the new product.
8. The competition prize is the supply of \$5000.00 worth of the successful design to the winning school. The prize will be delivered by Replas to the school at a time convenient for both parties, once the new product has been manufactured in commercial quantities. The \$5000.00 prize does not include installation of the product/s, if required.
9. The winning school will also receive an all expenses paid trip for two to Victoria, including airfares and transfers (if the winning school is interstate), to visit both the Research and Development plant in Lilydale and the Manufacturing facility in Ballarat. The winning school is responsible for deciding which two individuals will represent their school.
10. Prize may not be redeemable in cash.
11. The winning school must agree that images of the winning design and details about the school will be made available to the media. No images of students will be used in any publicity materials without the written permission of the school.
12. Employees and their families of Replas and the Green Bag Company are not permitted to enter into the competition.
